Through Sangitika, CRPIM aims to reconnect today's audiences with the original essence of Indian classical music—personal, soulful, and timeless.

Sangitika Baithak – Implementation Process

1. Invitation for Expression of Interest (EOI)

- CRPIM will announce an open call for Expressions of Interest from prospective hosts across India.
- o Individuals, families, organisations, music lovers, and cultural patrons can apply to host a Sangitika Baithak.

2. Assessment of Host Preferences

- o Based on the submitted EOI, CRPIM will understand the host's preferred **genre of music** (Hindustani, Carnatic, Ghazal, Folk, Instrumental, etc.).
- o Venue suitability, seating style, ambience, and capacity will also be reviewed.

3. Artist Selection & Recommendation

- o Depending on the genre and availability, CRPIM will curate a list of suitable artists from its network of classical and traditional musicians.
- o The final artist lineup will be recommended to the host for confirmation.

4. Event Planning & Coordination

- o CRPIM will coordinate with the selected artists, manage schedules, and finalise performance format.
- o Guidance on baithak aesthetics, seating layout, and traditional presentation will be provided to the host.

5. Promotion & Communication

- Each Sangitika Baithak will be featured and promoted on the CRPIM website, social media channels, and community mailing list.
- o Promotional creatives and event details will be made available for the host to share within their circles.

6. Financial Participation

- o CRPIM will **contribute towards the expenses** of the baithak as per predefined norms.
- o The host may also support additional arrangements such as venue setup, hospitality, or logistics, wherever applicable.

7. Execution of the Baithak

- o On the event day, CRPIM will ensure smooth coordination between artists and hosts.
- The focus will remain on maintaining the purity, intimacy, and traditional aesthetics of the baithak experience.

8. Post-Event Documentation

- o Photos, videos, and audience feedback may be collected to document the baithak.
- Key highlights will be showcased on CRPIM platforms to build the Sangitika community across India.

9. Special Feature of Sangitika

- o A select group of participating artists from the Sangitika Baithak Series will receive distinguished opportunities beyond the baithaks.
- Exceptional performers may be invited to feature at the prestigious grand Atharva
 Music Festival as well as in an upcoming international concert series, giving
 them a global platform to showcase their talent.
