- CRPIM will support artists through promotional campaigns, digital profiling, concert placements, and opportunities to collaborate with senior maestros.
- The festival will serve as a launchpad for deserving musicians to gain widespread visibility.

- CRPIM will organise international seminars, panel discussions, symposiums, and workshops on subjects related to Ghazal and Sufi music.
